The Jewish way – with good food and community

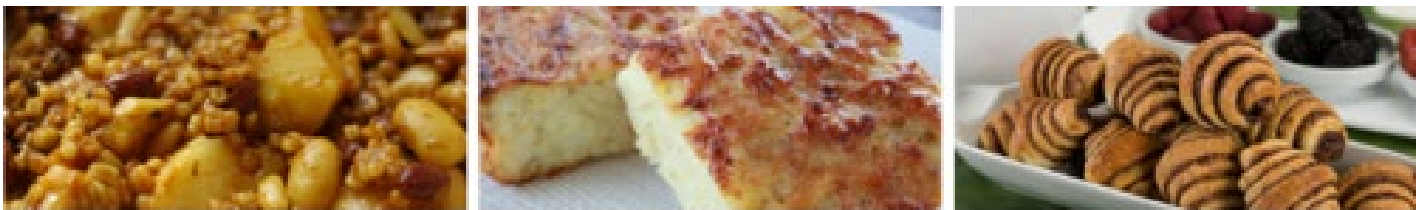

Our rabbi and cantor want to work with you as well to make the event most meaningful.

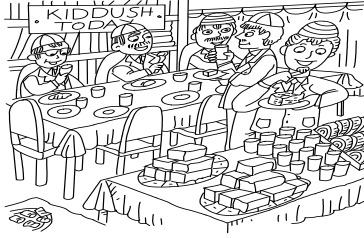
